THE first gourmet fish and chip shop in the area opened its doors in Grappenhall on Wednesday, July 7.

The Big Blue, based at 177 Knutsford Road, is a traditional English fish and chip shop with a difference.

As well as the regular cod and haddock, The Big Blue will be serving lemon sole and plaice in addition to specials like hake, salmon and turbot - all caught fresh daily from sustainable sources in Scotland.

Also on the menu will be the finest quality pies along with burgers with cracked black pepper and caramelised onion - all supplied from Cheshire-based Kirks Butchers.

The Big Blue was named by way of a competition run at St Wilfrid's Primary School, Grappenhall. The winning entry came from Harley Priest aged five who won the prize of a mountain bike.

Unfortunately, Harley was unable to receive his prize on the day, so his sister Sylvie, aged three and mum, Sue, stepped in on his behalf.

The main contractor was Urban Building Projects Limited, based locally in Hatton, whose specification was to convert the former florists shop into premises fit for a gourmet fish and chip takeaway. As well as carrying out major
